

CLOTHING/PERSONAL ITEMS

- One polar fleece vest
- One polar fleece pullover or sweater
- 3 quick dry long sleeve shirts (Buzz Off or similar works good)
- 3 quick dry t-shirts
- One pair casual pants for travel
- 2 pair light-weight polar fleece or quick dry pants
- 2 pair long underwear bottoms (best used with quick dry pants; light-weight polar fleece pants typically do not require long underwear for extra insulation)
- 6 pair socks (NO COTTON)
- Synthetic sock liners (optional)
- Hat (baseball cap works well under raingear)
- Stocking cap (synthetic/synthetic blend)
- Quality Gore-Tex raingear (top and bottom)
- Light-weight raingear top or wind-breaker
- Light-weight waterproof hiking boots
- Teva or Keen type sandal
- Sun screen, lip balm, **small** bottle insect repellent (non-aerosol)
- HEAD NET**; 2 Buzz Off (or similar) bandanas
- Bath towel (quick dry works best)
- Water bottle (large enough for the day)
- Small flashlight (L.E.D. headlamp works best)

FLY FISHING TACKLE

- 8' - 9' 4 or 5 weight fly rod (char, trout, grayling)
- 9' 7 weight fly rod (for mice/streamers & salmon)
- 9' 10 or 11 weight fly rod (king salmon)
- Single action reel for 4/5 wt. rod
- Salmon/saltwater reel for 7 & 10/11 wt. rod
- Floating line for 5, 7 & 10/11 wt. rods
- Sink-tip for 10/11 wt., optional for 7 wt.

The 7 wt. is the priority rod and will probably be used most often since it can catch everything except the kings... you may not have to bring all 3 rods if you can "share" the 4/5 or 10 weight rods between friends.

FLIES

- Mouse or lemming patterns
- Attractor dries (stimulators, club sandwich, etc.)
- Attractor dries (humpies, wulffs, etc.)
- Attractor nymphs (hare's ear, prince, etc.)
- Woolly and/or krystal buggers
- Egg Pattern
- Minnow pattern (zonkers, mudlers, zudlers, etc.)
- Egg Sucking or Starlite Leech
- Comet
- Bunny Fly or Hare Leech

FISHING EQUIPMENT

- Fishing pliers with cutters (forceps too small for salmon)
- Forceps (for smaller species)
- Small knife
- Hook sharpener
- Small fly boxes/lure boxes
- Gore-Tex type chest waders (stockingfoot)
- Wading boots (felt or "sticky rubber" sole; NO STUDS)
- Small fishing pack or vest
- Brown or Amber (not yellow) polarized fishing glasses
- Fingerless gloves
- Camera, spare batteries/film/memory (we can't recharge AC)
- Day pack for camera, water bottle, etc.
- Collapsible wading staff (optional)

For fly fishermen only:

- 8 - 10 lb. (2X or 3X) 9' tapered leaders, qty. 2
- 1X - 4X tippet spools
- 20 - 30 lb. tapered leaders, qty. 2
- 15 - 30 lb. tippet (small spools of monofilament work fine)
- 1/32 & 1/16 oz. bullet weights
- Strike indicators
- Split shot (various sizes)
- Fly floatant

SPINNING TACKLE (please, no treble hooks)

- 6'6" - 7'0" medium heavy, 2 piece rod/reel w/ 20 - 25 lb. test
- 6' medium, 2 piece rod/reel w/ 10 - 12 lb. test
- 5' - 5'6" ultra-light to light rod, 2 piece rod/reel w/ 6 lb. test
- 1/4 oz. Pixee spoon for smaller species
- 1/2 oz. - 7/8 oz. Pixee spoon for salmon (Pixee colors: silver blade with orange, pink or yellow)
- #4 Vibrax or Mepps spinners for king salmon
- #2 - #3 Vibrax or Mepps spinners for other species (Vibrax colors: silver on silver, blue, pink, red; firetiger/firetiger)
- 1/16, 3/8 oz. lead jig heads w/ 2" & 3" - 4" plastic grub tails
- Snap swivels, small foam bobbers approx. 3/4" in diameter
